Obeying in Faith

Thought: On one occasion, an elderly couple were taken to the hospital due to a car accident in South Germany. They were traveling in their vehicle, being guided by a malfunctioning GPS. At a given moment, their GPS told the driver to make a right, even though there was no street to turn to. As a result, the vehicle crashes into the interior of a church, leaving not only the driver and his wife severely injured, but also causing severe damage to the building's structure. The driver alleged that he did not know that the equipment was not working properly, and therefore he blindly put his trust in it.

Men: There are situations in which we place our trust on things that lead us to perdition, but we distrust the God that can lead us to a safe port. Where is your trust placed?

Scripture: "Abraham had faith and obeyed God. He was told to go to the land that God had said would be his, and he left for a country he had never seen." – Hebrews 11:8

Questions for discussion:

2. What barriers do you face in your life in order to trust in God?
3. How do you believe that you can overcome those barriers?
4. Which areas in your life do you feel that you need to obediently surrender to the Lord?
5. Which has been one of greatest faith challenges you have experienced?
